SOS Marine's ultimate goal is for safety to be integrated into everyday boating and offers a simple, safe and innovative way for sailboats and powerboats to retrieve overboard victims.

The **SOS Dan Buoy inflatable marker** and the **SOS 2 Person Life Raft** are compact and portable overboard rescue systems “light and easy” to throw in an emergency and suitable for all boat sizes.

With the patented SOS Dan Buoy it is a matter of just throwing directly into the water, no prior “assembling required” as deployment of the pole and flag requires too much time, says spokesperson from SOS Marine. Both rescue products are ready-to-use and offer excellent support while the skipper quickly decides how best to return to the victim.

The multi-award winning SOS Dan Buoy rescue system weighs around 8 pounds (4 kilos) and shaped similar to a ladies handbag. It meets Yachting Australia rules attached to the lifebuoy and in January 2014 Dan Buoys will comply with Yachting America sailing rules.

The SOS Dan Buoy has won several prestigious awards including the NSW Engineering Excellence Award for Welfare, Health & Safety.

The **SOS 2 Person Life Raft** weighs around 16 pounds (7.5 Kilos) offers coastal boaters travelling alone or with another person an easier system to use. The existing 4 plus person rafts are heavy and cumbersome for a couple to move into position. The SOS raft has optional emergency aids and a canopy. It is easier to maintain with reduced servicing costs.
