SOS Marine has combined a Lifejacket and Load Bearing Tactical Vest

Designed to fit over body armour with pockets and pouches purposed designed to suit the mission profile.

Design Features

- This combination of a lifejacket and vest is designed to be housed in an around neck collar valise which is attached to mesh vest.
- This vest has a zipper, number 10 heavy duty YKK, fastened at the front and is then tightly secured to the body with an adjustable waist belt. The buckle is a metal interlocking style.
- Pockets have been provided in the vest to house company's radios, and personal items.
- Additional pockets and pouches can added or deleted during manufacture to suit the requirements of the department.
- Firearm holsters can also be built into the vest during manufacture.
- The lifejacket vest is fitted with a manual-inflate system, which the wearer may manually inflate the chamber via a CO² gas inflator on the bottom right-hand side, by pulling on the yellow toggle. The wearer can also inflate the buoyancy vest via the oral tube on the left-hand side. Removable reflective or subdued lettering may also be applied.
- 150 Newton buoyancy bladder
- Side-adjusting tension webbing for multiple size fitting ensure a snug fit size
- Adjustable crotch straps are housed in an internal secure pocket of the vest.
- The adjustable waist belt has blackened 316 Marine grade stainless steel interlocking style buckles.
- **Optional** Detachable reflective department ID strip
- Webbing loops to secure radio cords and cabling
- Internal hook and loop attachment points for issue duty belt.
- Easy access storage space for tactical baton, communication equipment, medical kit, torch
- A pea-less whistle is provided for use in water.
- A **SOLAS** light has been fitted and is located on the front chest area. It is activated upon immersion in water and if necessary can be turned off during daylight.
- **SOLAS** grade reflective tape is located in a minimum of 6 places on the upper side of the buoyancy chamber.
- **Optional:** This vest incorporates a 3 litre personal hydration system 'hands free'
